# ACT

**An Act to amend the Constitutional Offices  
(Emoluments) Act**

[20th November, 2002

ENACTED by the Parliament of Zambia.

Enactment

1. (1) This Act may be cited as the Constitutional Offices (Emoluments) (Amendment) Act, 2002, and shall be read as one with the Constitutional Offices (Emoluments) Act, in this Act referred to as the principal Act.

Short title and commencement

Cap. 263

(2) This Act shall be deemed to have come into operation on the 1st April, 2002.

2. The principal Act is amended by the repeal of section *two* and the substitution therefor of the following:

Repeal and replacement of section 2

2. There shall be paid to the holder of an office specified in the first column of the schedule—

Salary and responsibility allowance

(a) a salary at the annual rate prescribed for that office in the second column of the Schedule; and

(b) a responsibility allowance at the annual rate prescribed for that office in the third column of the Schedule.

3. The principal Act is amended by the repeal of the Schedule and the substitution therefor of the Schedule set out in the Appendix to this Act.
